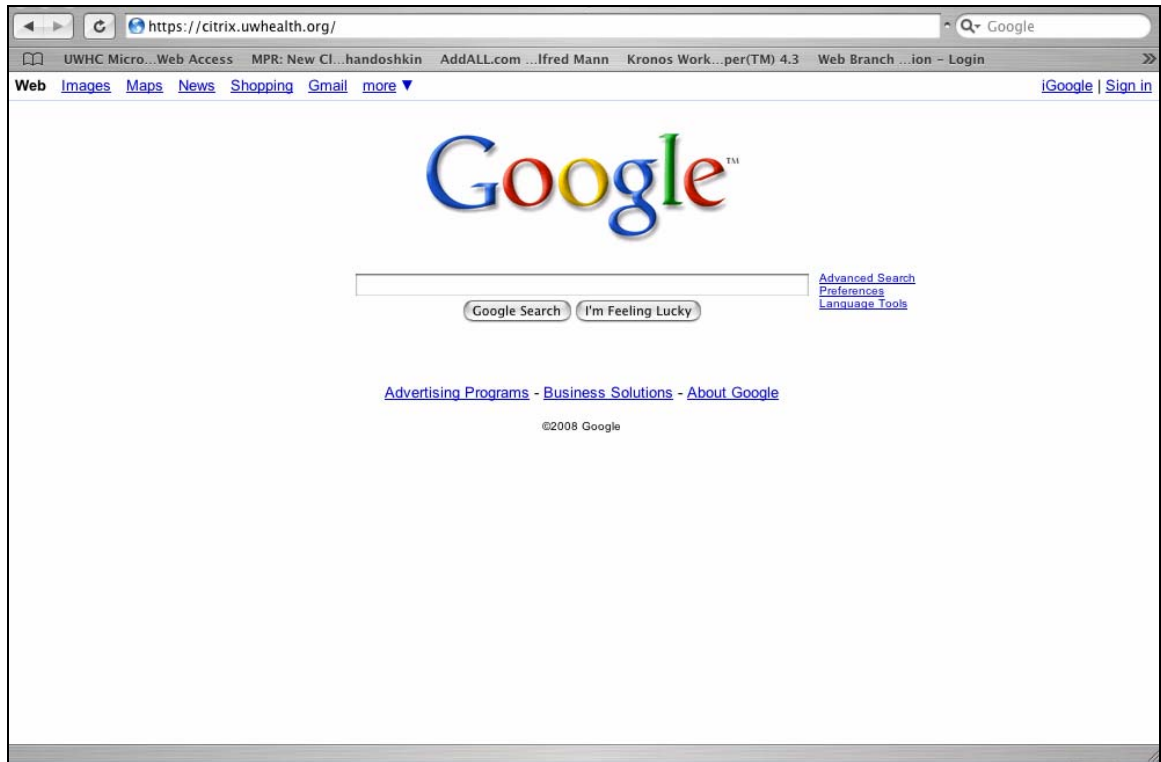
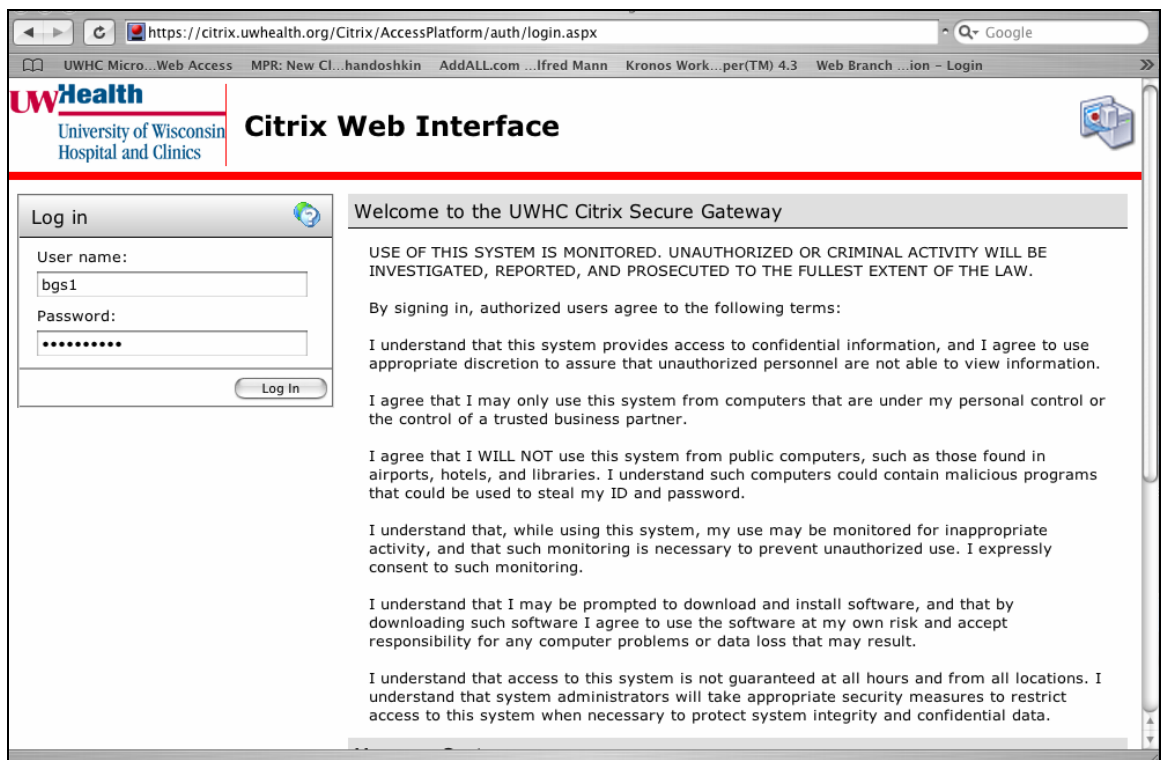


Citrix Remote Access on a Macintosh Computer

1. Navigate Safari to <https://citrix.uwhealth.org> as demonstrated below.



2. Once you are at the Citrix Web Interface, enter your Active Directory username and password. This is the same login you use for the UWHC Citrix Gateway, more commonly known as the 'Dictaphone E-sig' link on Uconnect.



- Once you have logged in, you should be able to choose any of the applications to open, provided you have installed the Citrix client from the message center.
