

CPR Certification Information Sheet

As stated in the *Appointment Information for Residents and Fellows* document, your appointment is contingent upon meeting the requirement of certification in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). **All residents must be CPR certified within the first three months of training and must maintain compliance throughout their training at UWHC.**

If you are **currently certified**, please send us a copy (both sides) of your certification card.

If you need to be **recertified**, meaning your card has not yet expired, you are strongly encouraged to complete this requirement **prior** to your start date. Contact your coordinator to see if you have already been scheduled for the required classes. If not, contact the EMS Office at the appropriate number listed below for information on recertification classes.

If you need to be **certified**, your certification has lapsed or you have not been previously certified, you are strongly encouraged to complete this requirement **prior** to your start date. Contact your coordinator to see if you have already been scheduled for the required classes. If not, contact the EMS Office at the appropriate number listed below for information on certification classes.

Additional Department requirements

ACLS / PALS / ATLS GUIDELINES

Medicine and Anesthesiology resident and fellows should be certified in ACLS. Pediatric residents and fellows should be certified in PALS. Surgery residents and fellows should be certified in both ACLS and ATLS. Physicians at the fellow training level in critical care or cardiology at UWHC, should be certified in ACLS, or PALS for pediatric fellows. Copies of all resident and fellow documentation should be forwarded to the Graduate Medical Education Office.
