Pre-Training Health Assessment Requirement

As stated in your appointment letter, your appointment is contingent upon the completion of your pre-training health assessment, a urine drug screen, mask fitting, and TB skin test placed and read by your clinical start date. The health assessment will take about one-half hour to complete provided you come to your visit with all requested documentation completed and up to date. You will not be able to begin your clinical training program until you have completed this requirement. In order for you to complete this requirement, please note the following:

- Immediately call for an appointment at EHS (608-263-7535) to complete your health assessment. With 150 new residents/fellows starting, appointment times will be tight.
- The health assessment at UWHC EHS is free of charge. Assessments, immunizations, done outside of UWHC EHS to meet the requirements of your health assessment for work at UWHC will be at your own expense.
- Immunizations and other requested information can be obtained from your medical school, your personal health care provider, family/personal records, EHS where you work/have done clinical rotations.
- Complete the attached Health Assessment form and gather all required documentation and any follow-up if necessary. Return the envelop provided or bring it with you to your appointment.
- **TB skin test:**
 - Must be placed and read prior to your clinical start date.
 - If you had a TB skin test completed within the past six months, obtain a copy of the test and bring it to your appointment or fax it to EHS 608-262-7284.
 - You may also have your TB test completed just prior to your arrival to UWHC. Again, bring a copy to your appointment or fax it to EHS 608-262-7284.
- **Urine drug screens:**
 - Needs to be done at EHS and will be completed at your appointment. No outside drug screens will be accepted.
- **Mask Fitting** will be completed at the appointment.
- EHS will notify the Graduate Medical Education Office when the above requirements are completed.
