Our fellowship trained sports medicine physicians and surgeons are the team physicians for UW Badger athletes so they understand the need for athletes to receive efficient and effective assessment and management of their injuries.

That's why UW Health Sports Medicine is introducing SportCare—a streamlined program to provide injured athletes with quick access to assessment and treatment.

### How does SportCare work?

SportCare allows injured athletes to be seen by a UW Health Sports Medicine physician soon after the athlete sustains a sports injury.

- Call the UW Health Sports Medicine Clinic at (608) 263-8850.
- Indicate that a SportCare appointment is needed.
- Bring any x-ray, MRI, CT studies or other pertinent reports to your Sportcare appointment.

If there are special needs or questions, our reception staff will forward you to UW Health Sports Medicine staff who will make sure you have the most appropriate care.

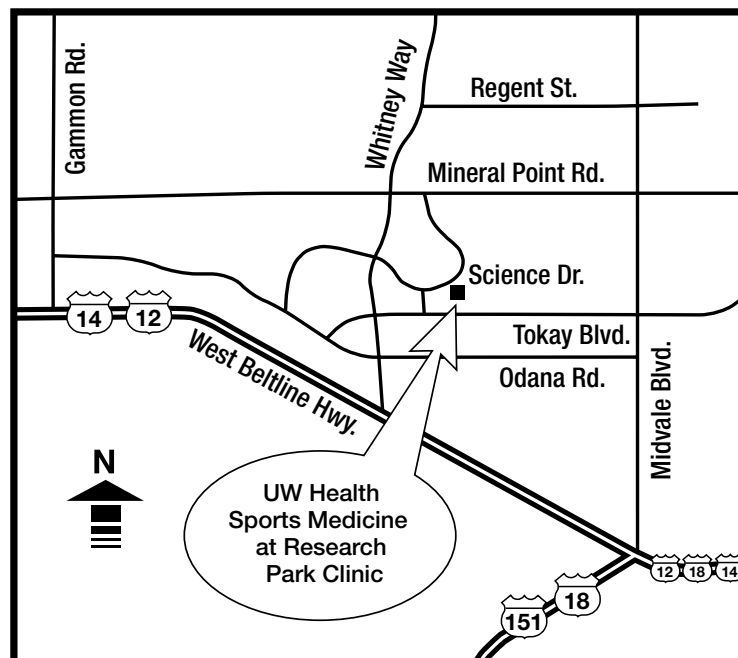
