Have a party!

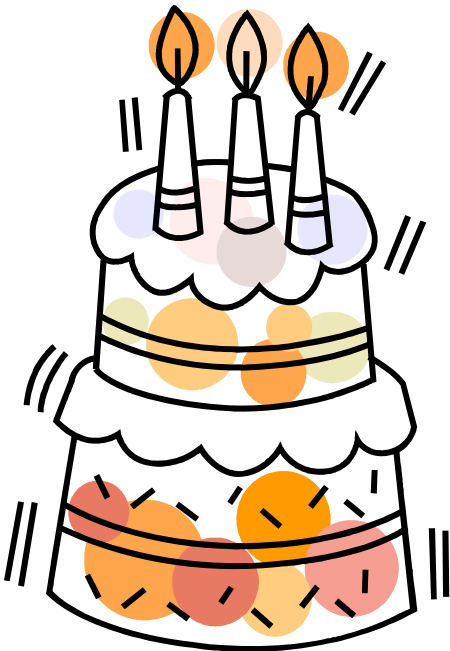
Celebrate!

That is how the Peter Pan Birthday Club started. Julia is all grown up now but she still celebrates her birthday the Peter Pan way.

You can do it too! Here's how:



1. Register with the Peter Pan Children's Fund (www.peterpanchildrensfund.org) so that they know when you are planning your party. You can register on line, or mail a note telling them all about your party. Select the American Family Children's Hospital to benefit from your birthday.
2. On your birthday party invitation, tell your friends that you want to help sick children and instead of a present, they should bring a check for the hospital in the amount that they would normally spend on a gift.
3. After your party, make a date with the hospital to present your birthday checks. Contact Terri Spring, Development Program Coordinator, at 608/890-9308.
4. Fill out the Peter Pan Gift Application; send it to the Peter Pan Children's Fund along with a letter from the hospital telling us about your birthday donation. When your Peter Pan Gift Application is received, they will send American Family Children's a \$100 gift in your name.

The Peter Pan Children's Fund will also send you an official Peter Pan Birthday Club Certificate and Order of Pan crest pin. Children and teenagers who submit a Peter Pan Gift Application will be eligible for consideration for induction into The Second Star to the Right Hall of Fame.
