### MILD or MODERATE Contrast Reaction

**SYMPTOMS:** Urticaria, diaphoresis, mild bronchospasm or dyspnea, facial edema, nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain, chest or throat tightness.

Consider exam without contrast or a different imaging modality. Otherwise, proceed with the prophylaxis protocol below.

#### Medication - Corticosteroid [136015]

methylprednisolone (MEDROL) 32 MG tab                      2 tab, 0, starting 7/12/17, Normal

#### Medication - Histamine H1 Antagonist (Single Response) [136016]

diphenhydramine (BENADRYL) 50 MG cap                      1 cap, 0, starting 7/12/17, Normal
