Proper Identification

- All staff members and volunteers are required to wear a UW Health-issued photo ID badge.
- Primary visitors (typically parents) receive a UW Health Visitor ID Badge from Security. All other visitors receive a sticker after completing a brief health screening.

Patient Safety

- Do not allow anyone to take your baby anywhere without your approval and your baby's nurse knowing about it.
- Do not allow other people to follow you into the inpatient unit. If someone follows you in, please let a staff member know immediately.
- If anyone in the hospital behaves suspiciously or makes you or your baby feel uncomfortable, please ask for your baby's nurse immediately or call Security at (608) 263-7065.

Parking Information

- Primary visitors (typically parents) receive up to two free parking passes for the American Family Children's Hospital parking ramp. These passes are issued by the Parking Office on Level "E" of the parking ramp.
- All other visitors must pay for parking with cash or credit card.

Outpatient Parking
