This requires nondiscrimination policy and practice, training in LGBTQ-centered patient care, inclusive employee benefits, engagement with the LGBTQ community and LGBTQ-focused patient services.

## Gender services provided

- Gender services navigator

- Surgical services:
  - Breast augmentation: increase breast size
  - Facial feminization: feminize head, neck and facial features
  - Hysterectomy, oophorectomy, vaginectomy: remove the uterus, ovaries and vagina
  - Orchiectomy: remove the testicles
  - Phalloplasty and scrotoplasty: create a penis and scrotum
  - “Trach shave” (thyroid cartilage reduction, chondrolaryngoplasty): reduce the size of the Adam’s apple on the neck
  - Top surgery/gender mastectomy: remove breasts and create a more masculine-appearing chest
  - Vaginoplasty: create a vagina, labia and clitoris
  - Voice/Pitch surgery: increase voice pitch
  - Zero-depth vaginoplasty: create a clitoris and labia, without a vagina

## Gender services locations and directions

### To University Hospital • 600 Highland Ave., Madison WI 53792

**From Highway 12/18:** Take Exit 258 onto Midvale Blvd. Proceed north on Midvale Blvd. approximately 2.5 miles. Turn right onto University Ave. Stay in the right lane for approximately 1 mile. Take a slight right and then turn left onto Highland Ave. Continue approximately one quarter of a mile to the front entrance of University Hospital. Turn left and proceed into the parking ramp.

#### Valet service

Free valet parking service is available at the front entrances, Monday–Friday: 5:30 am–7 pm

#### Self-park ramp

Patients may park in the ramp for free during clinic visits. To validate your parking, please take your ticket to the Clinics Information Desk inside the hospital. Parking for visitors is available in the ramp at hourly and daily rates.

### To 1 S. Park and 20 S. Park Clinics • 1 S. Park St./20 S. Park St., Madison WI 53715

**From Highway 12/18:** Take Exit 261 to Park St. Proceed north on Highway 151/Park St. approximately 2.3 miles. UW Health 1 S. Park Clinic will be on the right. Turn right on Braxton Pl. and an immediate left into the 1 S. Park Clinic parking lot. UW Health 20 S. Park Clinic will be on the left. Turn left on Regent St., then first left onto S. Brooks St. and first left into clinic parking lot.

#### Parking

Free parking is available in the surface lots at both clinics and in the 1 S. Park parking ramp on weekdays from 6 am–5 pm.

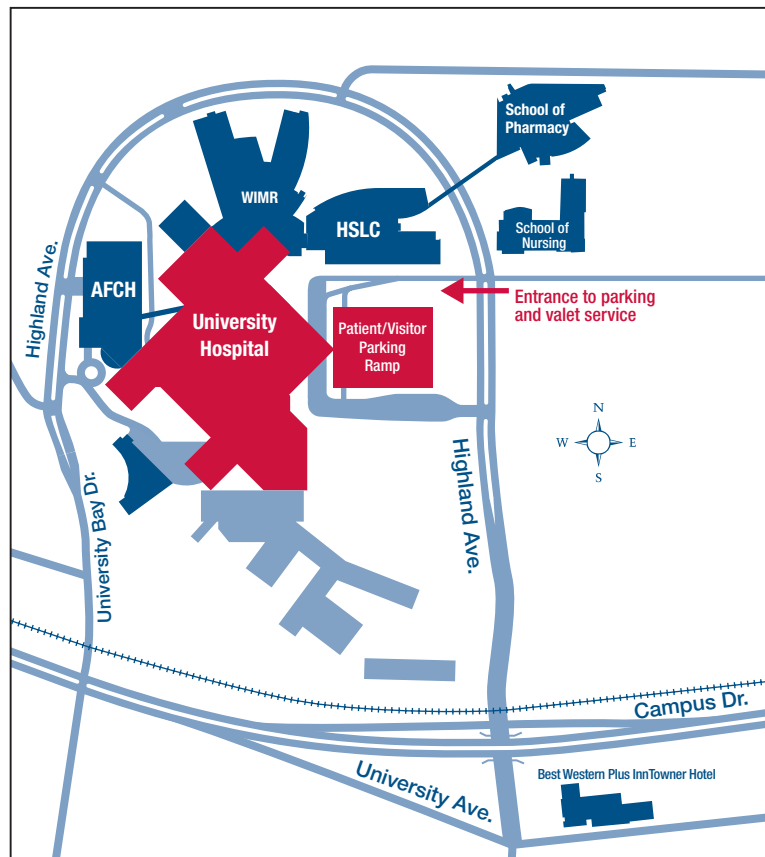
### To Transformations and Generations • 2349/2365 Deming Way, Middleton, WI 53562

**From Highway 12/18:** Take the US 14 exit toward La Crosse/Spring Green. At the end of the exit ramp, turn right to head west; stay in the right lane for about a quarter of a mile. Turn right on Deming Way; continue about a half mile; entrances to Transformations and Generations parking lots will be on the right.

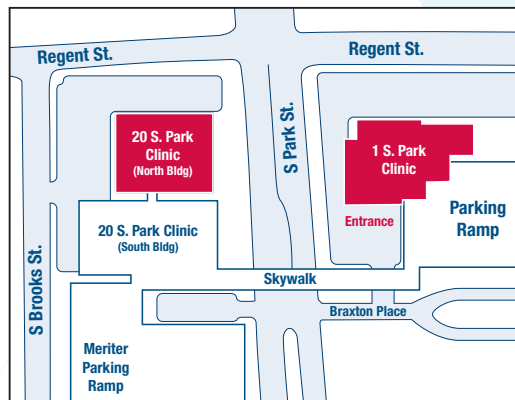
#### Parking
