**The Jim Collins Foundation:** If you and your doctor decide that surgery is part of your transition, and you need financial support because you do not have insurance or your insurance excludes these medically necessary procedures, please submit your application for consideration for a Jim Collins Foundation grant.

**Point of Pride:** Point of Pride's Annual Transgender Surgery Fund is a scholarship-like program that provides direct financial assistance to trans folks who cannot afford gender-affirming surgery.
