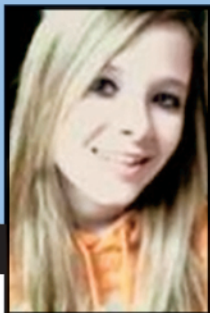


Ashlee's Gift
