Wisconsin State Employees Union (WSEU)

- 2,800 employees in diverse workgroups and titles ranging from custodian to dosimetrist:
 - Blue collar
 - Administrative
 - Technical
- Bargained on September 25, 2012 for wage increases in Years 3 & 4 of current contract
- Ratified by WSEU members October 17, 2012

Contract Terms

- Across-the-Board increases for all titles:
 - Year 3 = 2.4% and \$0.07 per hour
 - Year 4 = 2.4% and \$0.07 per hour
- Average wage lift:
 - Year 3 = 2.79% effective January 27, 2013
 - Year 4 = 2.77% effective January 26, 2014

Resolution of the Board of Directors of the University of Wisconsin Hospitals and Clinics Authority

November 7, 2012

WHEREAS, bargaining negotiations for a two-year wage reopener between Wisconsin State Employees Union (WSEU) and the University of Wisconsin Hospitals and Clinics Authority (UWHCA) commenced September 25, 2012; and

WHEREAS, a tentative agreement was reached September 25, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the WSEU members ratified the agreement October 17, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the UWHCA Board hereby approves the agreement that has been negotiated between the UWHCA and WSEU. The UWHCA Board hereby authorizes UWHCA to execute the contract and other documents necessary to memorialize and implement the contract.
